In 1863, President Abraham Lincoln designated the Medal of Honor as the nation's highest military medal for valor in combat. Since that time, the Medal of Honor has been earned by 3,516 recipients from every branch of the U.S. Armed Forces, every rank, every state, and nearly every walk of life.

The National Medal of Honor Museum in Arlington, Texas, will serve as the premier national institution dedicated to the ongoing impact of the everyday Americans who went on to become our nation's greatest heroes.

With this project, the Museum will encourage current and future generations to discover, develop, and deploy what it takes to rise above and beyond the call of duty—and awaken the hero in us all.

The National Medal of Honor Museum is a humbling yet empowering endeavor to preserve and expand the impact of the fewer than 4,000 Medal of Honor recipients and the more than 40 million Americans who have served in our Armed Forces since the Civil War.
